About

The NPH International Seattle Institute program welcomes a class of six university-age students from the NPH programs in Latin America and the Caribbean each September for a 10-month personal and professional formation and English study program. Homestays play an invaluable role in the students' experience – as a Homestay, you not only provide a home to the student during their time here, but they also become part of your family.

Homestay Requirements

- Preferably commit to 10 months (or possibly 4-5).
- Strong desire to include the young adult as *a member of the family*.
- Provide a safe and nurturing family environment.
- Near a bus route to Seattle Central (transfers are fine) – 1.5 hours is the maximum travel time from home to Seattle Central.
- Provide a bedroom with reasonable access to a bathroom (can be shared).
- Provide transportation to events and meetings (when they are at night or off a bus route).
- Provide all meals (this does not mean always cooking for them – just being sure there is food available for all meals).
- Desire to attend occasional events/community meals with the student, and participate in the program as appropriate, and support our activities.
- Willing to help with English homework as needed.
- Able to be flexible!!!

Preferred

- Have visited or volunteered at an NPH home, or been significantly involved with NPH, or the *desire* to become involved.
- Have cross-cultural experience or the desire to learn.
- An individual or family who would like to engage the student in their family activities and is invested in the program and the student's development.
